PERMANENT REVOLUTION an exhibition of Ukrainian contemporary art, will open in Ludwig Museum in Budapest in April 2018. Ludwig Museum in Budapest is among **30 museums all over the world** established and supported by Peter and Irene Ludwig international foundation.

This is the **first wide-scale museum presentation of Ukrainian contemporary art** to the European audience. The project organizer is Ludwig Museum in Budapest. The co-organizer of the event is Zenko Foundation.

The project is supported by Peter und Irene Ludwig Stiftung, Embassy of Ukraine to Hungary, Emberi Eroforrások Minisztériuma, MUPA Budapest, UTICO, Ost-West Express. The exhibition is organized in cooperation with Budapesti Tavasz Fesztival.

During the exhibition, works of **several generations** of Ukrainian artists will be presented in the context of social transformations happening in the country during the last three decades. These are the **most significant** names which have obtained **international recognition**.

A responsible exhibition curator from Ludwig Museum is its director **Julia Fabényi**, and curators from Zenko Foundation are **Alisa Lozhkina** and **Kostyantyn Akinsha**.

VIP OPENING, APRIL 5

On April 5 the Museum will host a **VIP** opening of Ukrainian contemporary art project. Among the guests are Ukrainian and European **collectors of contemporary art, business and cultural elites, directors of various museums and representatives of the diplomatic corps**.

The VIP opening will include a reception and project presentation.

LUDWIG MÚZEUM

Ludwig Museum – **Contemporary Art Museum** (Ludwig Múzeum – Kortárs Művészeti Múzeum) in Budapest was established by Ludwig Foundation in 1989 and contains a **considerable** portion of contemporary art collection belonging to Peter and Irene Ludwig.

The original selection features works by **Pablo Picasso, Roy Lichtenstein, and Andy Warhol**.
